



glass works

Fused glass is glass that has been fired (heat-processed) in a kiln at a range of high temperatures. Using different techniques, you can create colorful dishes, wall art, jewelry and more with glass fusing. This unique artistic method allows you to embellish fusing glass with patterns and personalized designs. Students will be introduced to a wide variety of fusing materials and techniques. In addition, we will examine various finished projects and discuss how they were made. Students will learn basic glass cutting and shaping skills; cleaning and layering techniques. Once you've taken the Introduction to Glass Fusing class, you can come in and use our studio space, molds, cutting and grinding tools to create your beautiful glass art.

party room rental

The classroom is available for rent on a first come, first served basis. The rental fee for a two hour time slot is only \$25. There are 2 time slots available: 12 - 2 p.m. & 2 - 4 p.m. Saturdays are the best days to rent the room, as during the week the room is often used for classes and events. The private, air-conditioned room includes tables and chairs, a fridge, freezer, microwave and sink. Parties can be booked up to 3 months in advance. Cancellations require at least a 48 hour advance notice for a refund.

At the time of your booking, you may reserve up to 15 max Pick & Paint items for your party activity. Seven colors of your choice will be shared among the party guest. We provide brushes, pallets & water cups. A running tab will be kept on the day of the party and any items not painted will be returned to inventory. hand building

Hickam Ceramic Shop offers hand building courses for both children and adults. The Hand Building with Clay course is designed take students through an exploration of working with clay, pinch pots, coils, and slab techniques. This is intended to be for students with any level of experience, so beginners as well as intermediates are welcomed to enroll. The course proceeds through a series of projects that will build the students' proficiency with understanding the basic foundations of clay manipulation and glaze.



pick & paint

From kid's figurines to large serving platters, we have an extensive selection of unfinished pottery ready for you to personalize. We provide glaze, brushes, stencils and sponges – all you have to do is pick your colors and get creative! The price of the pottery is on the bottom of each piece. The price includes the glaze, firing, supplies and studio time – no additional cost!

When your design is complete, please leave your item on the "Items Ready to Fire" shelf. It takes 14 to 21 days for your piece to be fired and ready for pick up. You can also call our studio to check if your item is done.

Need more time? If you are unable to finish your project in one visit, you may leave your piece on the "Works in Progress" shelf for up to 30 days.

Would you rather paint your pottery in the comfort of your own home or anywhere else you want? You can purchase your piece and pick your favorite colors to take home, to the beach, or wherever you like! Paint it up and bring it back to us to be fired. Stop by the Hickam Arts & Crafts Store to purchase a package of glaze cups and a few brushes and see how easy it is to paint on the go!

wheel throwing

Hickam Ceramic Shop has wheel throwing classes for ages 16 and up. Creating ceramic forms on the potter's wheel will be the main focus this course. Functional as well as decorative ceramics will be explored. Students will learn centering on the wheel, opening, pulling, shaping, trimming and glazing. The class will progress at each individual's speed.

Clay and tools are not included in the cost of the course.
Clay must be purchased from Hickam Ceramics. We do not fire outside clay.
