Homeschool Watercolor Class with Jeff Sanders

CLASS MATERIAL LIST

All of the required materials are carried by the Art Store. You may purchase new or use whatever you already have and feel most comfortable using.

Brush - One #10 Round Synthetic Watercolor Brush. The store carries both Princeton brand and Winsor Newton brand brushes.

Paint - At least one tube each of colors Yellow, Red, Blue and Green. The store carries sets by Reeves (student grade) and Grumbacher (artist grade) paints. Student grade are cheaper but artist grade give better results and value for the money.

Paper - One pad of 140 lbs. Watercolor Paper. The store carries the Canson brand.

Palette - Any plastic palette with deep wells will work. I suggest a plastic or foam egg carton or used ice cube tray to save money.

Water Containers (2) - One for clean water and one for dirty water. Any plastic container will work such as a 16 oz. plastic cup.

If you have any questions you may wait and purchase supplies on the first day of class.
